## FIFTH YEAR REPORT

### AFTER FIRST ACCREDITATION

## PART - A

The objectives set out in the plan of action for 2008 were as follows

1. In spite of rigorous effort on the part of the teachers, there is no significant improvement in the results, especially the B.Com results. More thrust is planned on this.
2. Organising seminars / workshops for students especially in the areas of
  - Computer literacy
  - Personality development
  - Internet usage
  - Dramatics
  - Practice examination, tutorials, preliminary examination etc
3. Intensifying the training efforts for cultural and sports activities
4. Organising lectures / seminars for female students in the areas of sexual harassment, legal rights of women, human rights, health issues etc under the Women Development Cell.
5. Establishing health care centre.

The achievements with reference to the plan of action during 2008 were as follows

1. College has been listed under Section 2 (f) and 12 (B) of UGC ACT 1956
2. Improvement in results

There was significant improvement in the T.Y.B.Com results. The pass percentage has gone up from 38% to 51% .The number of students securing first class went up from 6 to 37, with 11 students getting distinction.

The T.Y.B.A result has been maintained at a satisfactory level of 70%.

3. A workshop on Gender Equality was conducted from 10<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> November 2008.
4. A three weeks English speaking course was conducted from 25<sup>th</sup> March to 17<sup>th</sup> April 2008.
5. A Civil Defense workshop was organized from 10<sup>th</sup> November 2008 to 19<sup>th</sup> November 2008
6. A workshop on Internet usage was conducted.
7. A workshop on AIDS awareness was conducted during 7<sup>th</sup> Sept., 19<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> Nov.2008
8. A blood donation camp and blood testing activity was carried out on 10<sup>th</sup> January 2009.
9. The students and teachers participated in the programme organized by the Maharashtra Government to pay homage the martyrs of the terrorist attacks in Mumbai. Blood donation camp was organised for the same.
10. Coaches were appointed for sports training. (Cricket, Kabaddi)
11. Career counseling sessions were organized for familiarizing students with employment opportunities in organizations like LIC, ICICI bank etc. A counseling session was also organized in association with Institute of Cost and Works Accountants of India.
12. The NSS unit has undertaken a project in association with Mumbai Grahak Panchayat and has also adopted a village near Karjat. Number of students increased by 30.

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13. The college is continuing the practice of taking a group insurance covering all the students of the college. The total sum assured is Rs.9,25,00,000/-
14. Opening bank account for the First Year students with Bank of Maharashtra without charging any fees.
15. Special coaching to needy students.

The action plan for 2009 is set out as follows

1. Further strengthening of the efforts for improvement in results
2. Organising a state level seminar as part of the silver jubilee programme of the college.
3. Organising a university level cultural competition and sports meet as part of the silver jubilee programme of the college.
4. Making available health services to students covering free periodic medical check up facility. Medical help centre / services will be provided.
5. Continuing the group insurance and account opening activity for the students.
6. Taking help of Alumni Association in the career development programme.
7. Further strengthening of the library services.
