
As per the circular and guidelines received by the University of Mumbai and the State Government of Maharashtra, our volunteers attended and participated in various activities and events.

Total 28 NSS volunteers, one programme officer, a lady teacher, and an attendant participated in a 7-day residential camp held at above mentioned place and date. INAUGURATION & VALEDICTORY FUNCTION

INAUGURATION

We all reached the camp site on 23rd December 2019 to make proper preparation for the inaugural function and start of the camp. The camp was inaugurated on 24th December 2019 at 11.00 a.m. at the august hands of our honorable Prin. Ravindra Ghagas (Principal, SRK and MBBI College, Dahanu), Prin. V. B. Rokade, Prof. Vilas Jadhav (Director, Krushi Vigyan Kendra, Kosbad Hill) These dignitaries and guests delivered lectures and motivated our volunteer to work for the better cause of society and they appealed them to come out from their routine life and understand society not only to work for them but to be an instrument of change.

VALEDICTORY

Valedictory function was held on 30th December 2019 at 1.00 p.m. The function was chaired by Prin. V. B. Rokade, Prof. Vilas Jadhav (Director, Krushi Vigyan Kendra, Kosbad Hill) and Dr Nagesh M. Suryawanshi were present on the dais. The function opened with NSS song and 7-day report-reading of the camp. Report was read by Avinash Raut, NSS leader. Volunteers expressed their feelings, opinion and experiences telling how they enjoyed 7 days and developed various traits of personality that included leadership qualities, team spirit, coordination

and cooperation, spirit of adjustment and management. They found very happy with all these activities and shared their experiences. The camp strengthened their relationship and understanding to work together in future.

ROUTINE ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMMES

All the volunteers had a rising call at 5.30 a.m daily and they did physical exercise and yoga and sang prayer in accordance with strict schedule following the instruction of programme officer and leaders.

Meals Preparation:

Our volunteers prepared their breakfast and meals themselves. For this, group-wise activity was planned, and each group was offered opportunity to prepare meals and breakfast for them. This was a very enthusiastic activity as volunteers had their self-made test. It taught them a discipline of time management and skills of meals preparation.

Shramdaan:

Shramdaan was a regular and compulsory activity for all volunteers. As per the instructions and plan for Shramdaan activity, they carried out this activity at various sites and places. They cleaned roads in the camp site, schools' premises, gutters, well, toilets, girls and boy's room, common grounds and class room. Also, they made soak pits. This activity taught them value of physical labour.

Skit Presentation:

Skits based on social themes- Superstition and Gender Sensitization were performed at Ashram school, at Kosbad hill.

Guest Lectures & Group Discussion:

Our camp schedule included guest lectures on various social and environmental issues to create awareness among our volunteers. Various guest speakers visited the camp site and delivered lectures. Also they interacted with them and got satisfied with the volunteers response and preparation. Group discussion was organized to develop oratory skills and communicative ability of our volunteers.

Sports & Games:

Our volunteers enjoyed various sports and games during their leisure time in the evening. It was a good recreation for them. This not only brought fun for them but developed a good understanding and spirit of enjoyment among them.

Survey & Visits

Socio-economic survey was undertaken in the village and Adivasi Padas to know their culture, lifestyles, earning sources, farming, festival and other issues of interest. This activity was conducted into group-wise. They were given forms to fill in the information mentioned above. Total 50 forms were filled in by the volunteers.

School Activities for Children

Various activities for Ashram School children were conducted by our volunteers. These included Sports, Drawing competition and interaction with them. Prizes were awarded to them. Our volunteers conducted other activities with these school children and motivated them for better life.

Thus, the 7-day residential NSS camp came up with many learning aspects and proved an instrument of change for our volunteers as they learnt the importance of team spirit, fellow-feeling, adjustment, decision-making skills, discipline and overall a changed personality with a new approach for their further life.
