7-Day Residential Camp Report-2022-23

As per the directives of NSS Cell of Mumbai University, Mumbai, a 7-day residential camp was organized at Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Kosbad Hill, Tal: Dahanu, Dis: Palghar from 13TH JAN, 2023 TO 19TH JAN, 2023. Total 13 NSS Volunteers attended the camp along with a Programme Officer, a lady representative and a peon. Inaugural function was organized at 12.00 p.m. which was chaired by the I/C Prin. Dr. Krishnan Nandela sir. On this occasion Prof. Vilas Jadhav Director, KVK, Kosbad Hill, Dahanu, Prof. A. R. Yadav, Shah & Anchor Kutchhi Engineering College, Chembur. (Master Trainer, L&T Training Institute, Varsova, Mumbai) and KVK college staff were present. With this inauguration camp activities began. On 13th Jan planning and distribution of work was made by Maya Bheke, NSS leader, Two groups were formed with their title-name as Krishna and Godavari. Daily, each group was allotted alternative schedule of activity to perform at the camp site as Cleanliness, support to volunteers for breakfast and meals preparation, Hospitality and Shramadan.
